Join [Minuteman Indivisible \(MI\)](#) and [Harvard Medicine Indivisible \(HMI\)](#) at a panel discussion, *America's Healthcare: What's Next?*, where noted experts from Harvard medical and area healthcare communities will delve into this thorny issue.

## Forum topics include:

- Not all Americans are insured under the Affordable Care Act. Will millions more lose health insurance coverage if the ACA is replaced with something else?
- Will nursing home residents lose Medicaid coverage?
- How can healthcare costs (premiums, deductibles, out of pocket expenses, etc.) be contained?

The discussion will also explore varied facets of a [single-payer system](#) (i.e. Medicare-for-all, like Senator Sanders' new bill [Medicare-For-All Act of 2017](#) and MA S.619 [An Act establishing Medicare for all in Massachusetts](#) presented by Jamie Eldridge) —that views healthcare as a human right, and successfully serves nations across the globe.
